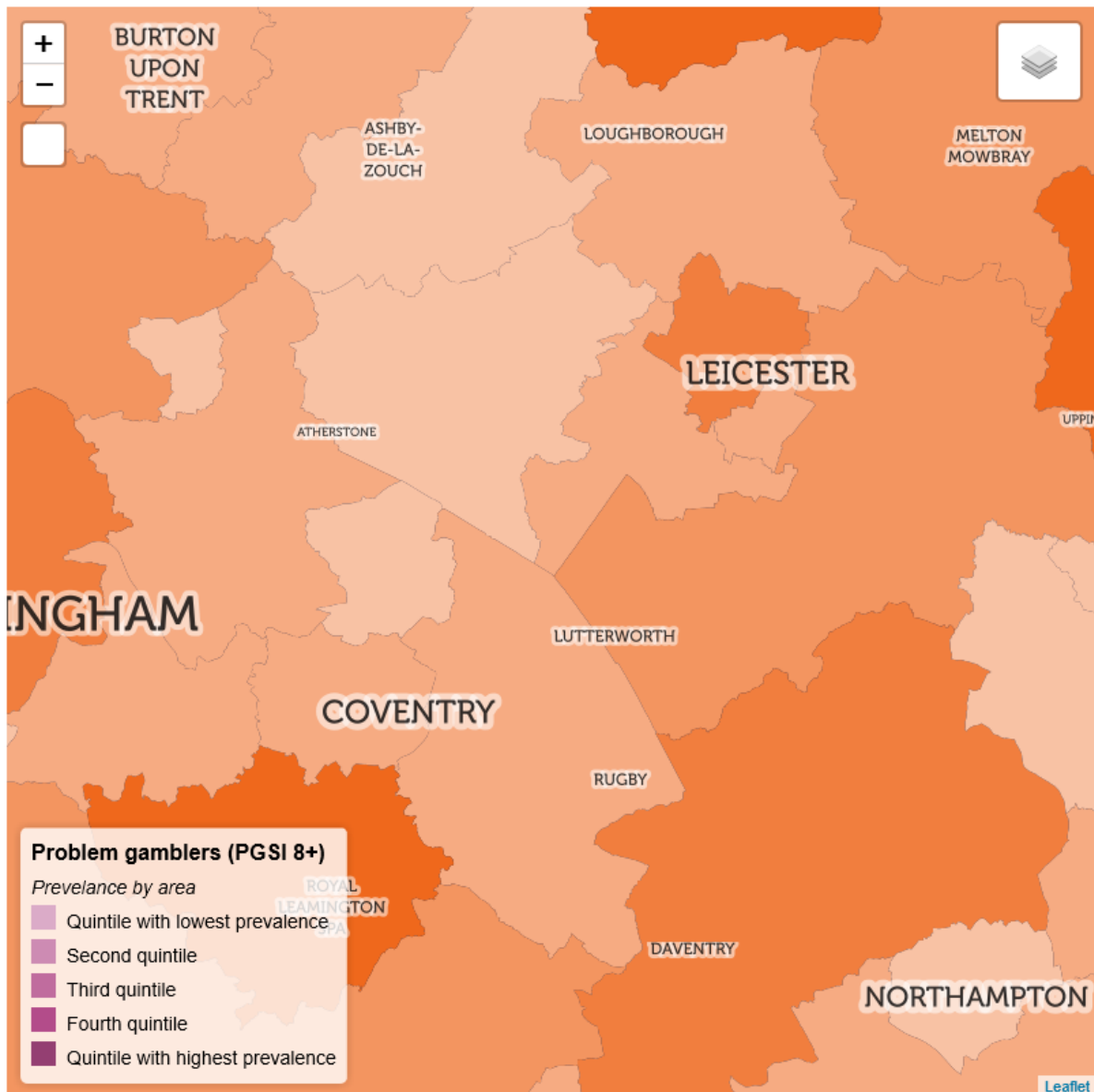


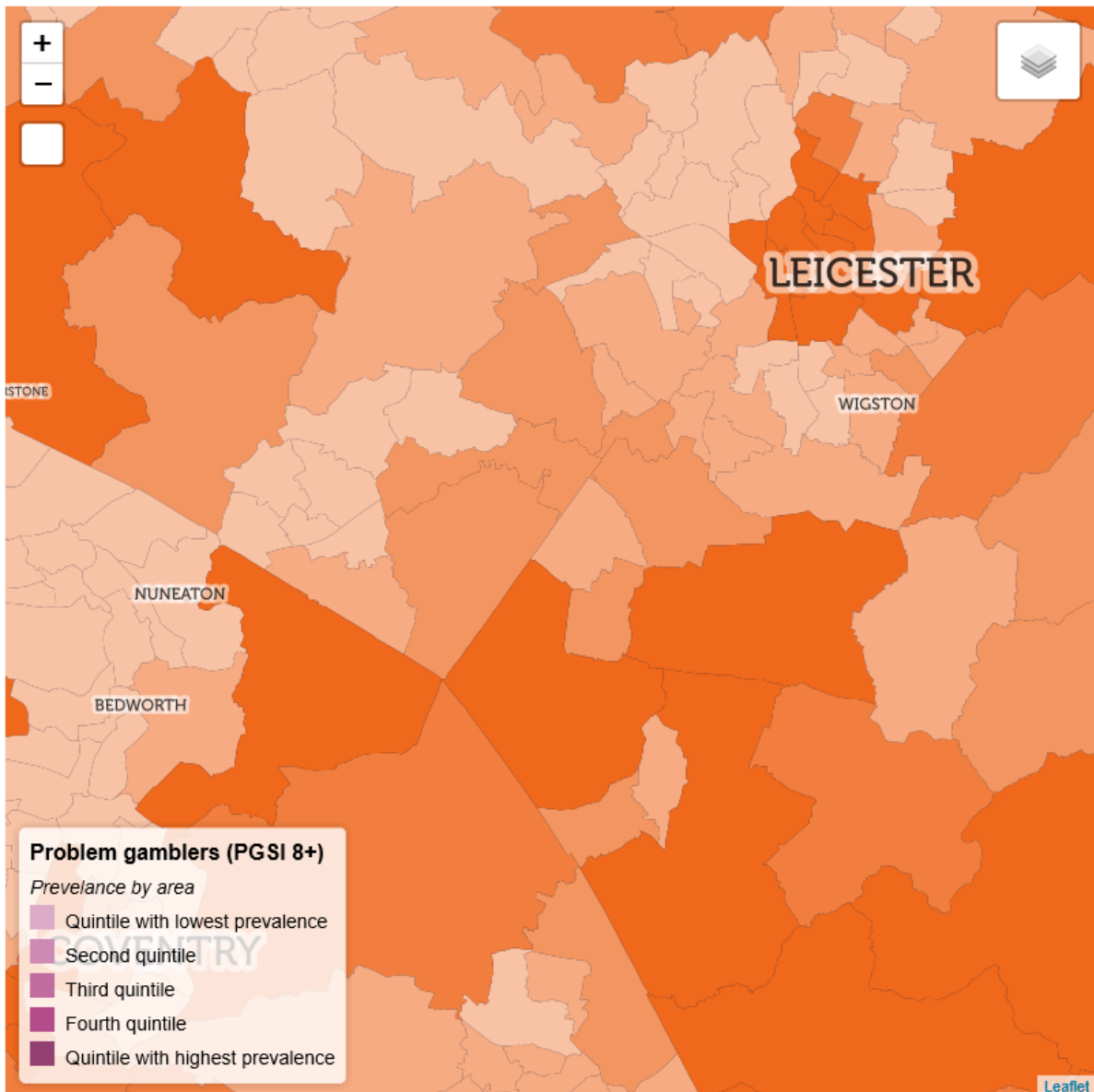
Map 1 – Gambling prevalence based on PGSI scores

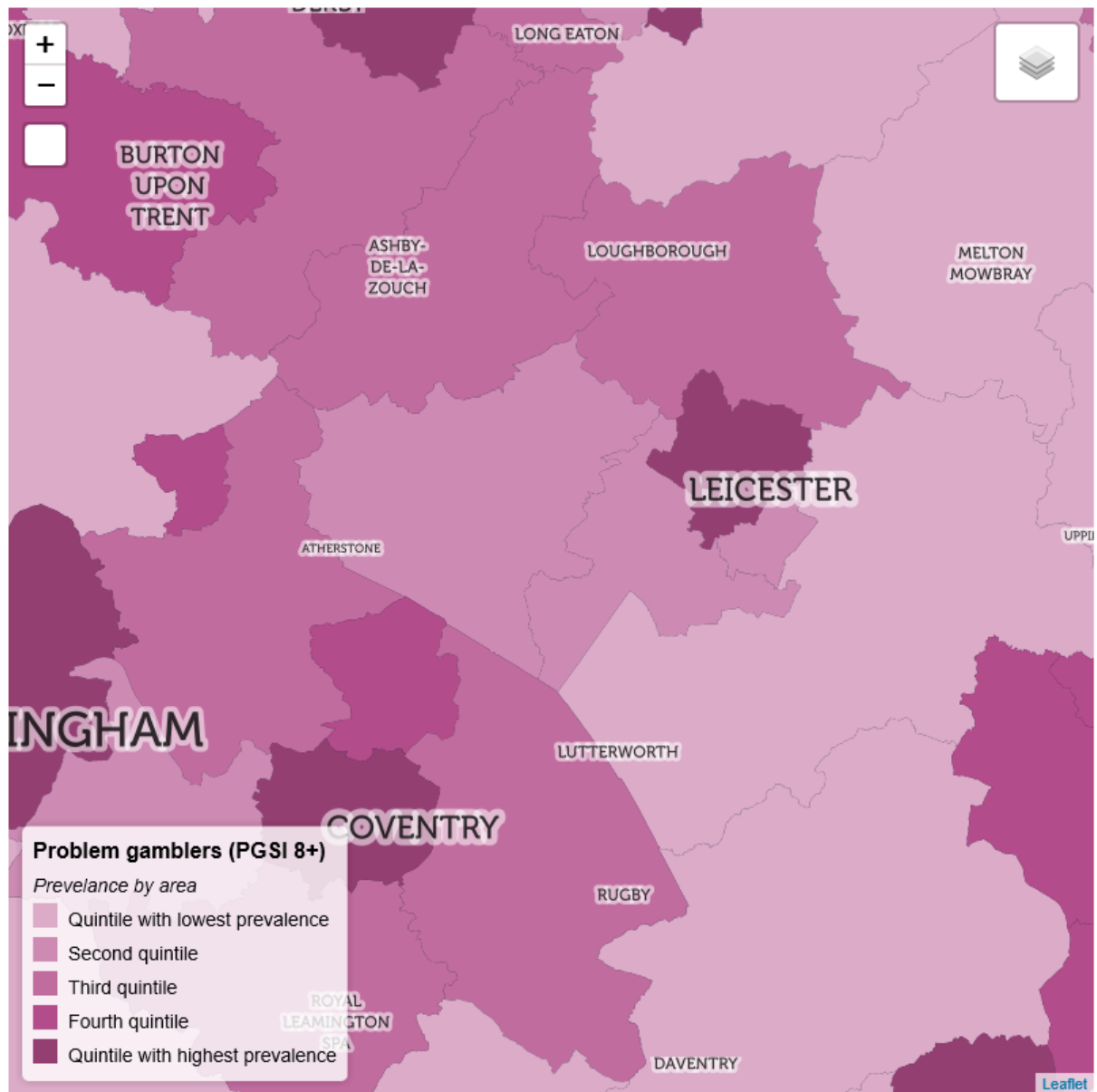
a) Non-problem Gamblers - Local Authority



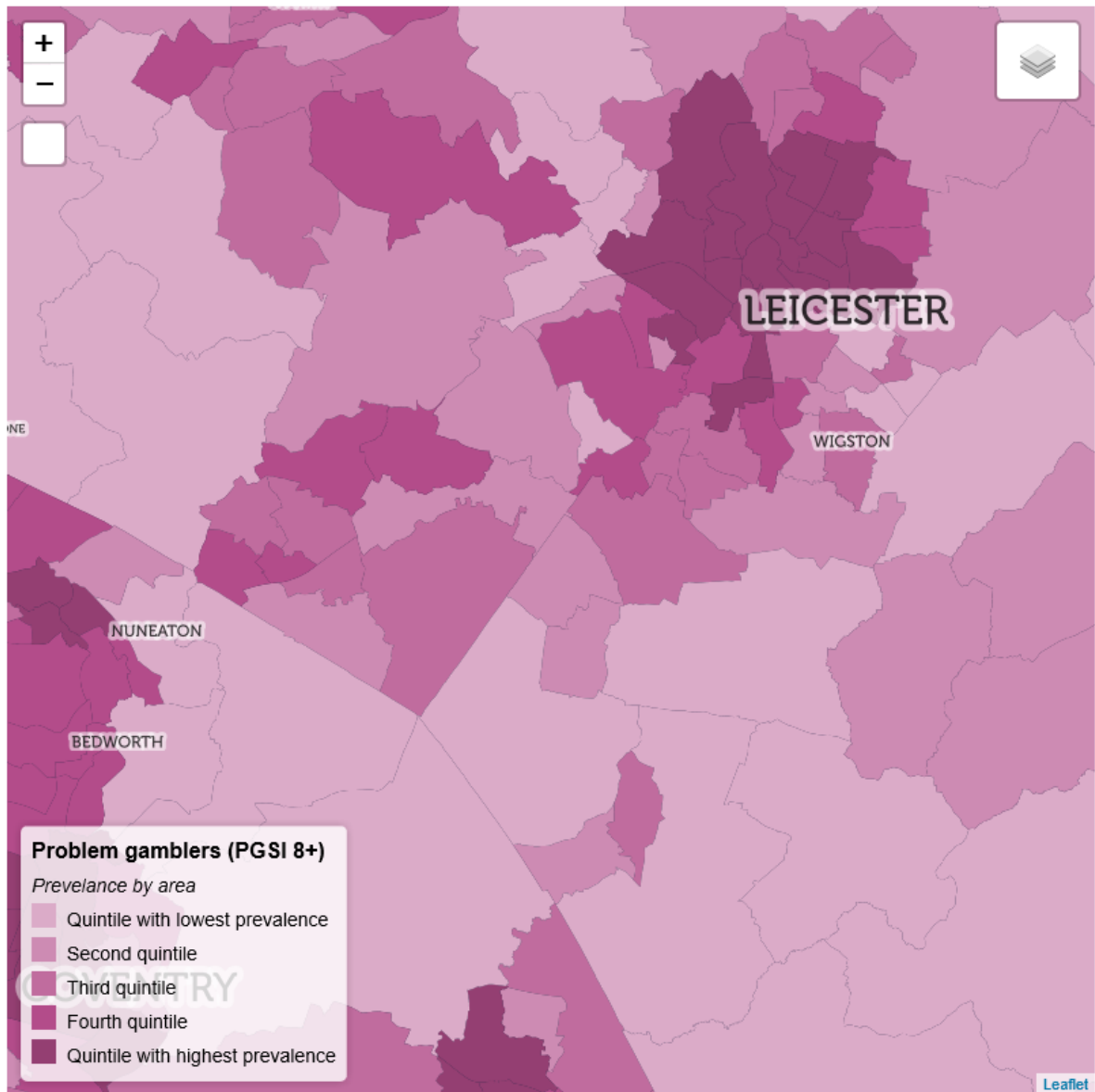
b) Non-problem Gamblers - Ward



c) Problem Gamblers - Local Authority



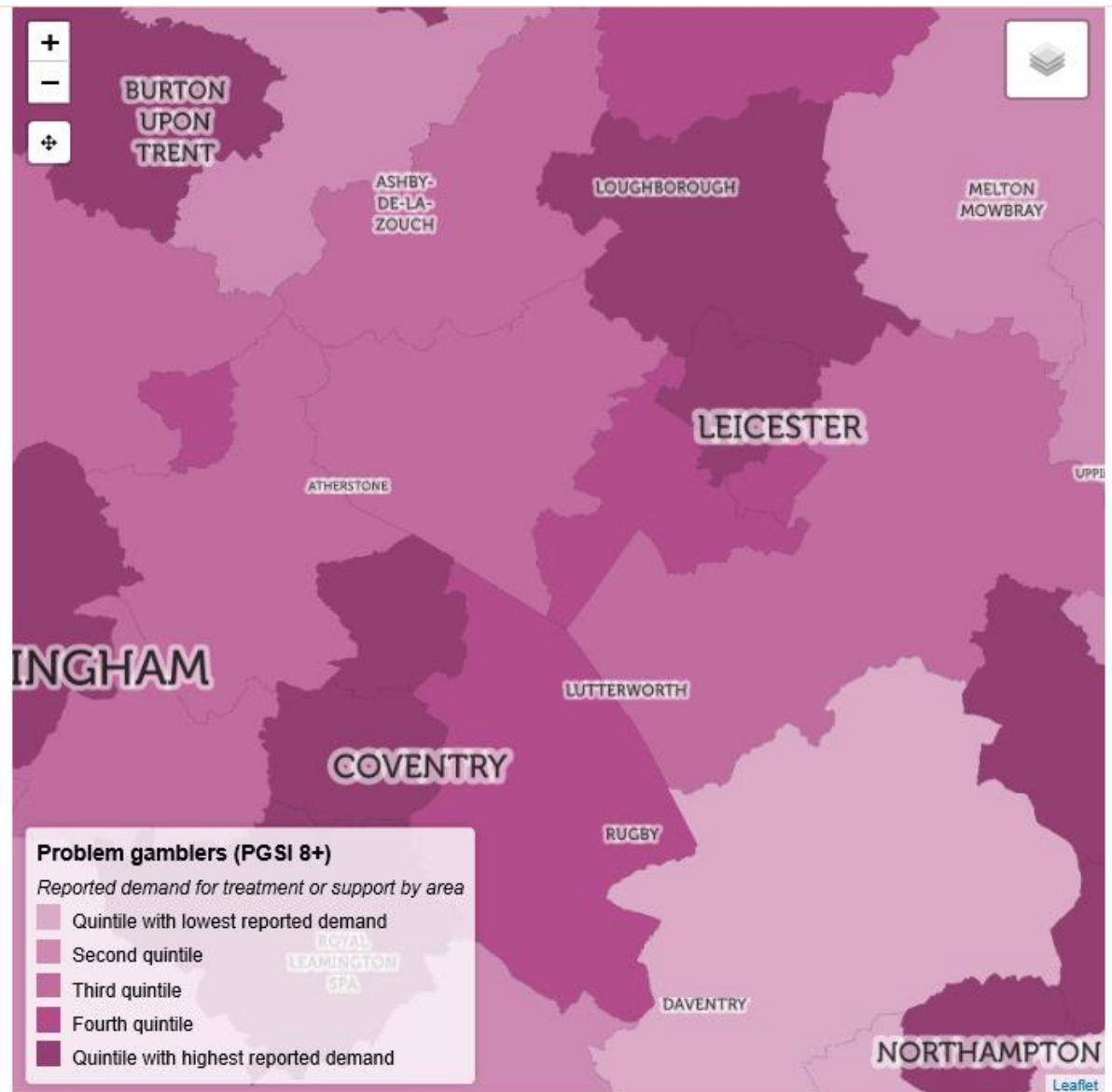
d) Problem Gamblers - Ward



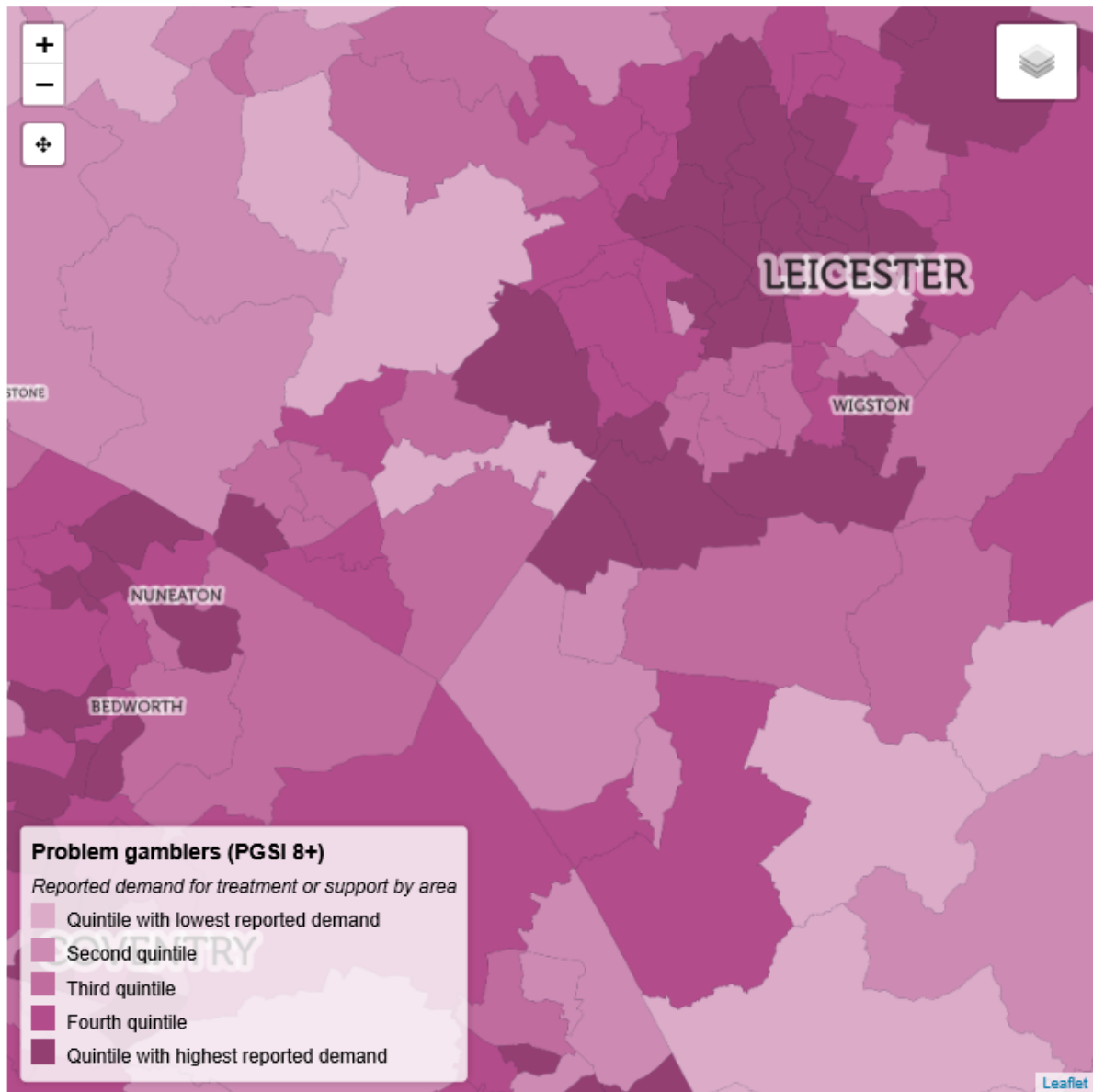
Map 2 – Reported demand for and usage of treatment and support

a) Reported demand for and usage of treatment and support by problem gamblers - Local Authority



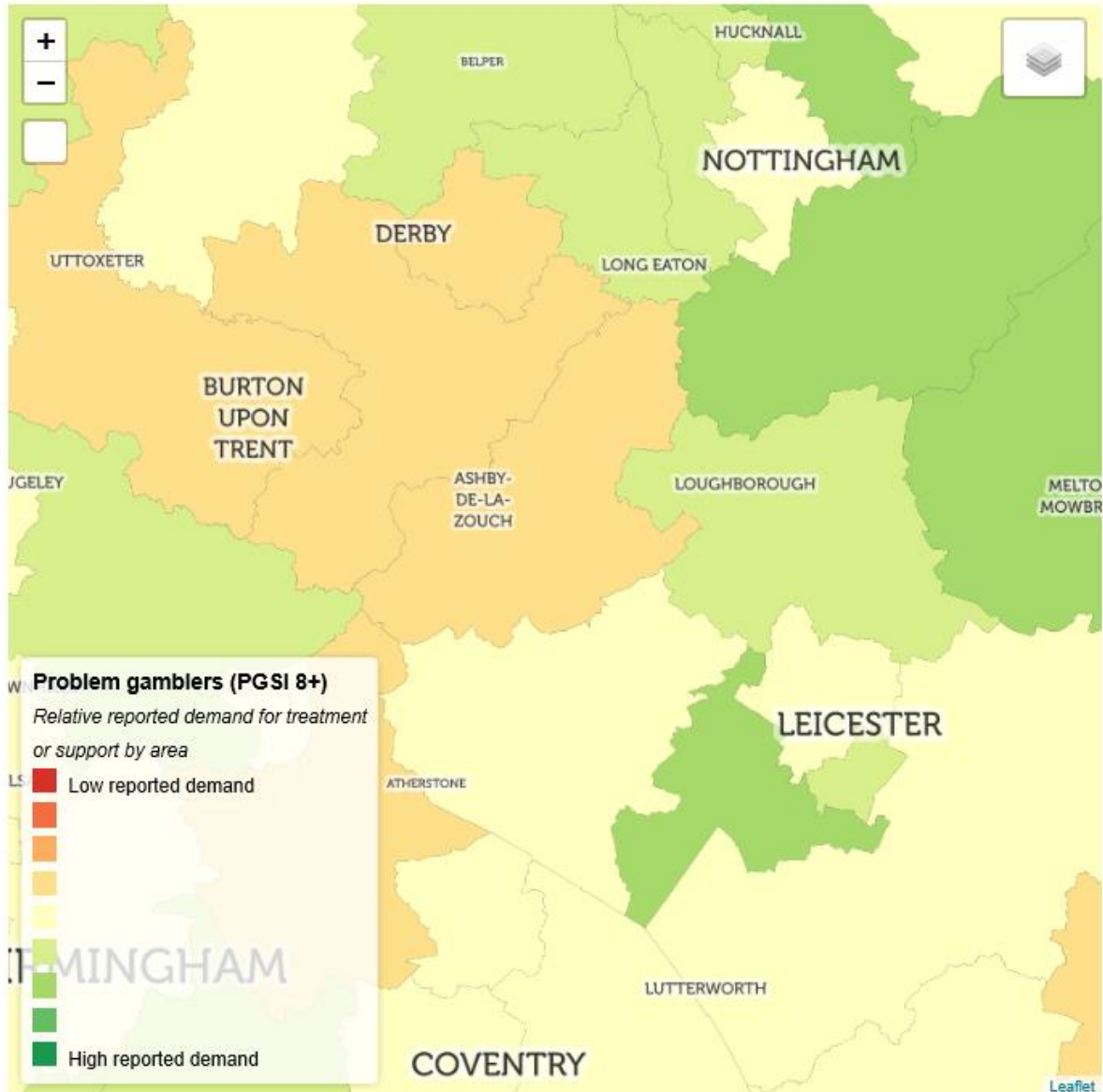
b) Reported demand for and usage of treatment and support by problem gamblers - Ward
